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Our Vision...

It is the goal of Lubbock-Cooper South Elementary School to provide for each and every student a quality education, a sense of community responsibility, a strong awareness of character, and an appreciation for the value of good citizenship.

A little bit about us...

Lubbock-Cooper South Elementary (South) is the original Lubbock-Cooper Elementary School, and served as the only elementary school in the district until 2002. In addition to its historical significance to the district, South is known as a traditional, family-oriented campus.

South serves 750 students* from pre-school through fifth grade. There are 57 certified teachers* on the campus, and the student-teacher ratio in the classroom is 22:1.

What we offer...

South Elementary follows the TEKS Resource System curriculum and incorporates Scientifically Based programs, Response to Intervention measures, and Best Practices. South is also a partner school with Texas Tech Teach and additional universities/programs for educator preparation. In addition to maintaining state requirements, the South campus offers students several unique learning opportunities including Gifted and Talented, English as a Second Language, intervention, a full time Community In Schools Site Coordinator, a focus behavioral interventionist, dyslexia services, enrichment, before- and after-school tutoring, full-day art and music programs, day and evening student performances, differentiated instruction, Balanced Literacy Framework, full technology integration, integrated social studies, third and fourth grade science pull-out, Apple TV, document cameras, Kelso's Choice, Character Counts, center based hands-on instruction, MyOn, IRead, one-to-one iPad to student, Osmo Educational Gaming System, Read 180, System 44, Lippencott, a Macbook cart, phonics-based spelling in all grade levels, Fuel-Up-To-Play 60, and a recycling program. We also have various after school clubs for a nominal fee.

Students are also encouraged to participate in a number of extracurricular activities! Parents are welcome to get involved with the CEPA program, which sponsors annual Open House, Fall Festival, Night of the Arts, Talent Show, Olympic Day, and more!

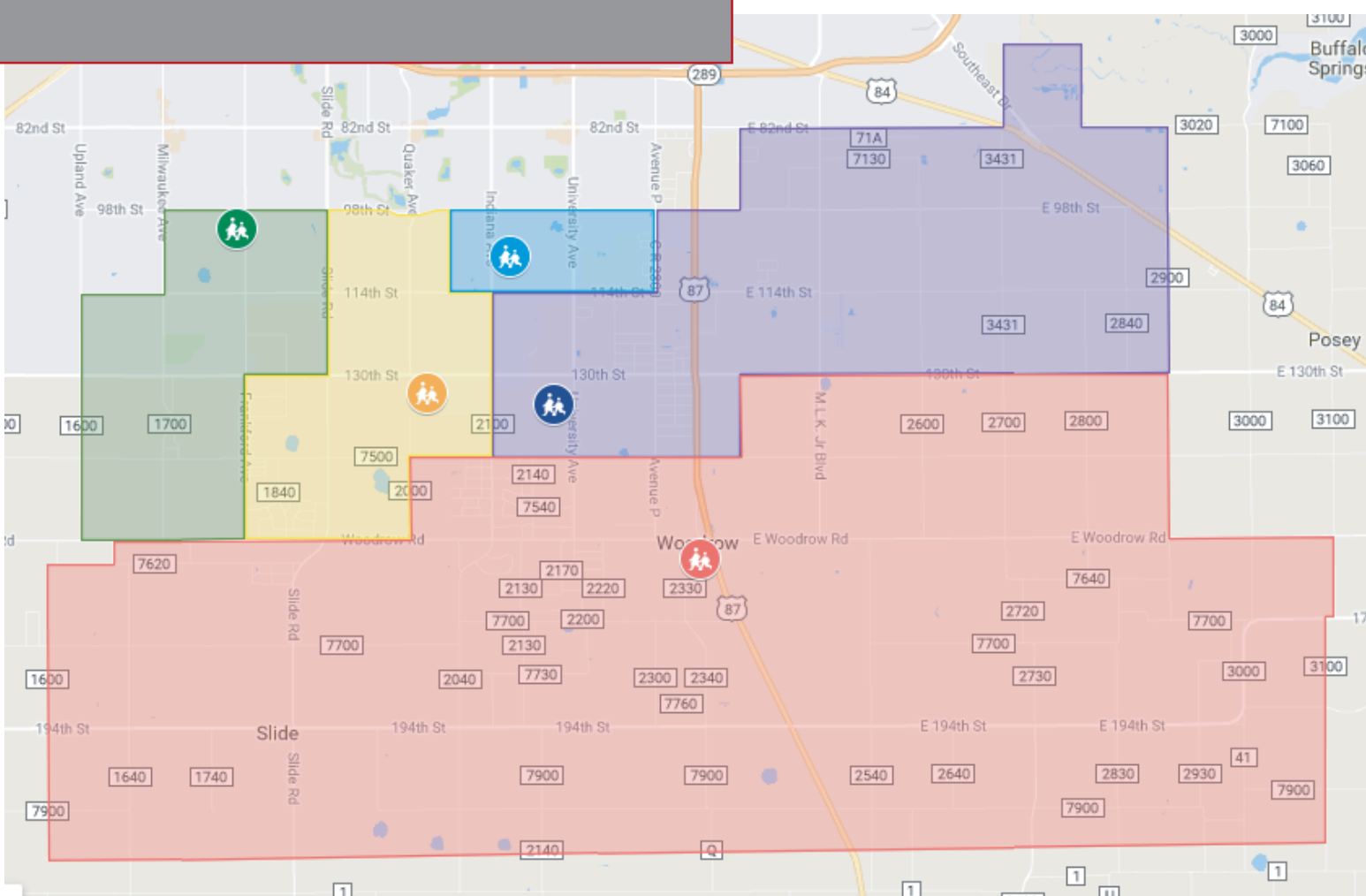
A typical day...
