Procedures (8-10)	<p>This is nine weeks test week. We will REVIEW on short and long “a”, “e”, “i”, “o”, “u” words</p> <p>Our comprehension skill is main idea and details, story structure, text and graphic features, compare and contrast. (RL 1.1, RL 1.7, RL 1.10)</p> <p>Our vocabulary strategies is classify and categorize, multi-meaning words, and synonyms. (L1.5b, RF1.3g)</p> <p>Our fluency skill is identifying beginning and ending sounds, using diagraphs –ch, -th, -sh, and –wh in words, and identifying syllables in a word.</p> <p>Saxon Phonics and Michael Heggerty book is used as a supplemental program to teach/reinforce phonological awareness and phonics skills.</p> <p>We will review nouns, verbs (present, past, and future tense), pronouns, adjectives, writing the date correctly, and how to write a complete sentence using correct punctuation.</p> <p>We will continue to write to describe a topic recalling information from a story using a writing prompt (first, next, then, and last).</p>
