# Science Olympiad Information



## Selection Process for Hansen Elementary Division B Team (Grades 6-8):

Monday, August 26: Science Olympiad Application will be available on Google Doc. The link will be sent to all 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade parents and students via email

Friday, August 30: All applications are due along with RSVP for written and build tests; this deadline will NOT be extended

Thursday, 9/5: Written test will be given in the Multipurpose Room at 3:10PM. Only students who have sent a completed application and RSVP for this test will be allowed to test; doors close promptly at 3:10. Parents are not permitted in the MPR during testing. Top 50 scorers will be notified and invited to the build test.

Friday, 9/6: Top 50 scorers from the written exam will be invited to the build test which will be at 1:45PM in the Multipurpose Room. The doors will close promptly at 1:45; parents are not permitted in the MPR during testing. Build tests will be scored by Hansen teachers and admin.

Tuesday, 9/10: Science Olympiad results will be sent to students and parents via email at 4:00PM. Results are final.

Thursday, 9/12: Parent Meeting for students selected for teams in the Science Lab, 7:00-9:00PM. Information regarding tournaments and team expectations will be given at this time.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Attending school has a huge impact on student success. This year we want to make sure every student misses no more than 9 days of school, or 1 day a month. We need your help.



**Some Attendance Tips to Promote Student Learning:**

- Make sure your student keeps a regular bedtime and establish a morning routine so they are rested and alert when they get to school.
- Turn off all electronics including TVs, phones and tablets at bedtime.
- Make sure clothes are ready and backpacks are packed the night before.
- Check with our school nurse or office staff if you are not sure about when to keep your child at home due to illness.
- **Avoid scheduling vacations or doctor's appointments when school is in session.**
- Talk to teachers and counselors for advice if your student feels anxious about going to school.
- Develop back up plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, neighbor, or another parent to take your student to school.

Please let us know how we can best support you and your student so that they can show up for school on time every day.
