Dear Students and Parents,

As we transition into summer break, we are pleased to offer our students the opportunity to continue their pursuit of excellence in Talmud Torah through our optional summer learning program. The optional summer learning provides an opportunity for students to participate wherever they are for the summer by choosing one of the options below.

Students may choose from the following two options (or do both) with the incentive included alongside.

1) **Gemara** – Students are encouraged to learn **part of the 7th perek of Massechet Shabbat beginning with the mishna on 73a until the end of the perek (76b) AND the entire 12th perek of Massechet Shabbat (102b until 105a)**. Any student who completes the perek with verification of a parent email will receive a test grade of 100 added to his Gemara average.

2) **Chumash** – Students are encouraged to learn the following parshiyot in Sefer Bamidbar **with Rashi: Pinchas, Mattot, Masei**. Any student who completes this project with verification of a parent email will receive a test grade of 100 added to his Chumash grade.

There is no need to “sign up” for the summer learning program. Please send the verification email to me (ezra.wiener@tabc.org) sometime before the first day of school.
