



HOME VISITS

Why home visits?

We value you. We want to understand your *hopes* and *dreams* for your child. We want to know what your family cares about most and what you hope we can do with your child at our school. We want your child to know that we are a part of their network of support. We *love* your kid. We want to make sure they have every *opportunity* in this world available to them, and we know that begins with deep, meaningful *relationships*.

What are home visits?

Home visits are 30 minute visits where two Phillips staff members will visit you and your family. We will get to know each other, ask you about your hopes and dreams, and learn the best way that we can *communicate* and *collaborate* together. This is about building *relationships*. You trust us with the privilege of spending everyday teaching your child. The least we can do is spend some time getting to know you.

How does this work?

You will be contacted via phone, email, letter or Remind ahead of time by a Phillips staff member to schedule a visit. Then, we'll come see you at that time - simple as that! You don't have to prepare anything ahead of time; we just want to sit down and *get to know you better*.
