



## Weldon City Schools COVID-19 Update

March 25, 2020

Weldon City Schools is closely monitoring the mandates and circumstances related to COVID-19 and how it is impacting our education system, our families, and our community. Governor Roy Cooper recently mandated that school buildings remain closed for students through May 15, 2020. As a result of this mandate, Weldon City Schools will continue with its COVID-19 initiatives, which include the following:

### Office Hours

Weldon City Schools is continuing to work to ensure we are available for our families as we face the impacts of COVID-19. To curb the spread of the coronavirus, we are moving towards conducting business with minimal personal contact. Every school office and district office will continue to be available by phone from 9 am-4 pm. We apologize for the inconvenience, but safety continues to be a priority for our district.

### Remote Learning

Weldon City Schools will continue to make various Remote Learning platforms and other instructional resources available on our district website for student's Pre-K through 12th grade. Until or unless Weldon City Schools employees are required to stay at home, we will continue to provide food and instruction in a variety of ways to our students. Instructional initiatives include learning packets, online instruction, telephone call centers, and a blended model involving multiple modalities of learning and instruction. Students and parents are encouraged to call their schools to get guidance about what type of instructional options are available to them.

### Meal Distribution

We will continue to provide meals for our families for as long as we possibly can. We will continue to deliver meals at bus stops from 10:45 until 12:30. District-wide pick up for meals will continue at Weldon Elementary Global Academy. There will be no meals served during the Easter Break, which will be from April 10, 2020, through April 17, 2020.

### Spring Break

As a reminder, Spring Break will be from April 10, 2020 through April 17, 2020. Schools and the Central Office will be closed. During that time, meal distribution and student work packets distribution will cease. We will resume our meals and student work packet distribution after spring break, reconvening on April 20, 2020.

### Facility Access and Athletics

Due to the Governor extending the executive order for the closure of school buildings, all school and district-wide events scheduled now through May 15, 2020, are canceled. Additionally, all facility rentals are cancelled during that time. Athletics will remain suspended until further notice.

We will continue to keep our families up to date with the latest information. Should you have any questions or concerns about remote learning, meals, the calendar, or other issues, please reach out to your child's school or the Central Office.
