THE CALIFORNIA UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT

New Haven Unified School District invites all licensed contractors to submit information for inclusion on the district's CUPCCAA Contractors List for the 2019 calendar year. The qualified contractors list will be posted on our website at the beginning of each calendar year. For the 2019 calendar year, the district has chosen to start a new contractor's list. A contractor may have their firm added to the contractor's list at any time by providing the required information below.

Public Contract code 22032 and Public Contract Code 22034

The California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA) is under the umbrella of the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Commission (CUPCCAC) and provides for alternative bidding procedures when an agency performs public project work by contract. Effective January 1, 2019:

- a. Public projects of \$60,000 or less may be performed by the employees of a public agency by force account, by negotiated contract or by purchase order.
- b. The governing body of the public agency may, by adoption of a resolution by a four-fifths vote, award the contract, at \$200,000 or less, to the lowest responsible bidder, if it determines the cost estimate of the public agency was reasonable.

State Labor Code Requirements for Public Works

Independent from the CUPCCAA but required for all Public Works:

Labor Code 1725.5, requires all contractors and subcontractors intending to bid or perform on a public works project to be registered and annually renew under the DIR Registration Program for prevailing wage compliance. The DIR fee is paid directly to the State by the contractor. The District will not register a contractor, nor collect funds.
