# Tuition & Fees (2018-2019 Rates)



## Plan A

\$7,810

- ✓ Mandatory Fundraisers: A total of \$400 will be invoiced separately to the account.
- ✓ 25 Parent Service Hours per year (\$20 fee for each hour not served)
- ✓ Missed Parent Meeting Fees (\$25 each of four meetings)

## Plan B

\$9,975

- ✓ No Fundraising or Missed Meeting Fees and No Parent Service Hours
- ✓ Families choosing Plan B are ineligible to apply for financial assistance.

# Additional Costs



**All families are responsible for the following fees regardless of the Tuition Plan:**

- Application Fee \$30 per new student (fee is non-refundable)
- HSPT Fee \$30 per new student (fee is non-refundable)
- Registration Fee \$500 per student (fee is non-refundable). If you pay on registration day which is March 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> it will only be \$400-savings of \$100.
- Textbooks \$200-\$500 per student dependant on classes
- Uniform \$200-\$300 per student dependant on options chosen
- Sports Fee \$100-\$350 per student per sport. (each sport varies)
- Advanced Placement (AP) fee \$60-\$90 each course
- Freshman Summer School \$250

# Payment Plans



**Bishop Conaty – Loretto High School offers flexible payment plans.**

All students are required to have a FACTS tuition agreement. BCLHS collects tuition ONLY through FACTS Tuition Management Company.

## **Payment Plan Options**

- ✓ One automatic payment to FACTS of the full amount of tuition for the 20-2019-2020 school year due August 1, 2019
- ✓ Two automatic payments: First Semester due August 1, 2019, Second Semester due January 2, 2020
- ✓ Eleven automatic monthly payments: July 1, 2019 through May 1, 2020

Decision letters will be sent in March 2019.

## FACTS Grant & Aid

- Log on to <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/470TS>
- There is a required \$35 application fee per family that is charged by the FACTS Company.
- After completing the online application families need to upload or fax supporting documentation.
  - Copy of your 2017 IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040-EZ Income Tax Return
  - Copy of your 2017 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements
- You may contact the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Customer Care Center Monday through Thursday from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm Central Standard Time and Friday from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm at 866-441-4637 with any questions.
- BCL staff will be on-site to assist families with completing their applications by appointment on the following days:

# Bishop Conaty – Our Lady of Loretto Tuition Assistance Process

- To be eligible for tuition assistance consideration, families must adhere to the deadlines. The deadline to apply for BCL aide is January 31, 2019.
- Applications for assistance are confidentially reviewed by the Tuition Assistance Committee. In addition, the committee reviews principal recommendations, grades, attendance and conduct in ranking students within the awarding guidelines. The committee strives to consider each applicant family's unique situation.
- The Tuition Assistance Committee is comprised of members of the Consultative School Board and a Department of Catholic Schools staff member. The Business Administrator confirms that all application documents are received and may contact you if further information is needed. Decision letters are sent from the Principal with records maintained in the Business office.
- Bishop Conaty – Our Lady of Loretto High School has a limited amount of funding for tuition assistance. Sources include the operating budget, donations and grants received, and Endowment income. The process and awarding guidelines the Tuition Assistance Committee has established provide an equitable tuition assistance program to serve the BCL community.
- We understand that the availability of tuition assistance funds will impact both your decision and ability to send your daughter to BCLHS. Our goal is to complete the award process so we may notify you of your grant amount with your acceptance letter during the first week of the month of March 2019.
- Families who are awarded tuition assistance are asked to sign and return a letter of award acceptance.

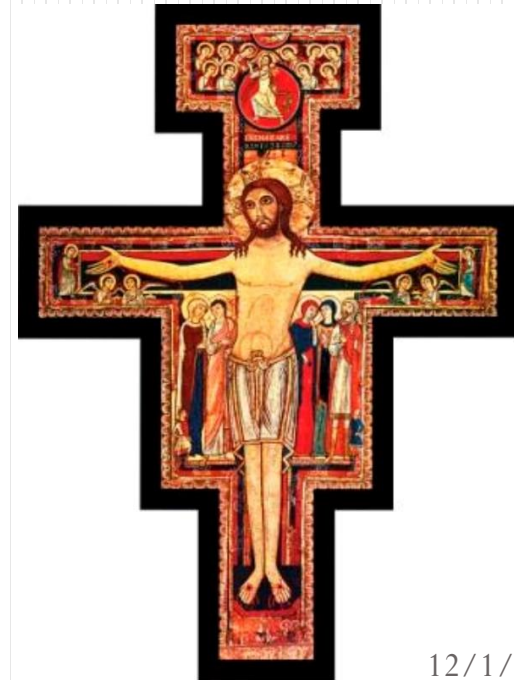


# Scholarship Information

- The \$30 High School Placement Test Fee is waived for students who complete and pay the application fee at Open House, December 1.
- A \$100 Registration discount is given to incoming freshmen who register by March 9, 2019
- Continued Academic Excellence: \$1,000 Scholarships are awarded to the top 5 scorers on the HSPT. This is renewable each of the four years provided that the student achieves a 3.0 G.P.A. in each semester.
