

Advanced Placement (AP) Course(s)

Advanced Placement Course Contract

School Year 2019-2020

Students who choose to enroll in an AP course(s) must understand that:

1. AP is a **college level course** designed for academically prepared and motivated high school students. It is expected that all students enrolled will sit for the AP exam at the end of the school year. All enrolled students must pay the AP exam fee to take the exam. AP course grades are calculated on a 5-point scale giving the students the opportunity to earn higher than a 4.0 GPA.

**AP exams fee are approximately \$95.00 per exam.

**AP Capstone (AP Seminar AND AP Research exams fees are approximately \$150.00 per exam)

****The deadline for payment of exams is May 31, 2019.*

2. AP courses are rigorous and will maintain *college level expectations and pacing*. Students should expect to do *at least 1 hour of homework* per AP course outside of school each day. Students who have trouble completing assignments or understanding course content are expected to seek help.
3. Summer work will be assigned in May 2019 prior to the end of the current school year. These assignments will be factored into 1st quarter grades. As such, failure to complete these assignments will have a detrimental effect.
4. Selection of AP course(s) should be done thoughtfully and with serious consideration to commitment. Parents are required to sign the registration card as well as this form acknowledging that the student will **not be allowed to withdraw** from an AP course after **May 31, 2019, when payment is due**. Taking AP courses is by choice, and in making that choice, students are committing to working hard and to continuously challenge themselves. Additionally, students interested in taking **more than three** AP courses in a school year will be required to get approval from Ms. Kaneshiro, Post High School Counselor/AP Coordinator in the College and Career Center, room A1.
