# HALLWAYS

- No one out of class the first 10 minutes & Last 10 minutes
  - Fundamental Five “ Framing the Lesson”
  - Critical Writing
- Must have a hall pass (Vests)
- Students are to keep moving in the hallways
  - At the door greeting and welcoming students.
  - Teachers actively monitoring for safety.
- 4 Minutes between classes
- No phones or wires in the hallway.





## TARDIES

1<sup>st</sup> period only- Must pick up tardy pass or absentee slip at Attendance Office (100 /400hall).

Absent after 8:15. Must show slip to enter class.

2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>- Teachers record Tardies. Ms. Teal pulls data and assigns consequences.

For each Semester the tardy consequences are as follows:

3 Warnings

**4-8** tardies is Lunch detention.

**9-12** tardies is After School Detention

**(13 & greater will result in ISS)**



# AUTOMATIC OFFICE REFERRAL

- Cheating
- Skipping Class
- Uncorrectable or consistent dress code violation
- Fighting or confrontational behavior
- Profanity/Racial Slurs in class
- Refusing to surrender electronic device
- Vandalism or defacing school property
- Non-compliance/defiance
- Refusal to attend teacher d-hall
- Public displays of affection



# CONSEQUENCES

## DRESS CODE

## B.Y.O.D.

Devices may used at breakfast and lunch; not during class or transition.

Devices should be turned off and stored in all other areas.

**EMERGENCIES:** Ask teacher or Admin.!

**EXCEPTION:** For Instructional Use as directed by teacher.



# ATTENDANCE

Students may not miss more than 9 unexcused days in a 6 month period. (9 )Non A.D.A absences in a class per semester = loss of credit in that class.

ALL undocumented excuses must be turned in within 3 days of the absence to the attendance office. (Non A.D.A. absences beyond 9 must be made up)

5 Parent Notes per Semester. Notes must be reviewed before being approved. Forging notes is a violation of the code of conduct. Part day doctor - no penalty!

# Cafe

- Seated or in a line.
- Rest room OK not first 10 or last 10.
- Devices OK. ( Sound must be private)
- Communication must be at “table tone”.
- Outside Food must have “sticker” from front office.





# Tutorials

- AM – must have pass to teacher.
- PM- check in and check out with A.S.D. to get a late bus pass. ROOM 505.
- Students must be supervised while on campus.



# Assemblies

- Speakers- Be respectful. (No Devices.)
- Games – Be respectful (Prayer and National Anthem- be still, quiet, no phones)
- Pep Rallies- Sit or stand in Class areas. Be Spirited.
- Parents on front rows at pep rallies
- (Teachers will sit with students)



## Parking and Drop Off

- North Side (Tennis Court)-Staff Parking only
- East Side (front) – Busses AM and PM. Visitors.
- South Side- Student Parking and Parent Drop off and pick up. Must have a pass from front desk to enter parking lot during the day. Then return pass to front desk.
