

# The Frank Ryerson Scholarship

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

Grateful anonymous donors have established The Frank Ryerson Scholarship at Notre Dame High School to honor Mr. Ryerson's legacy of excellent teaching and leadership. Mr. Ryerson's tenure here at Notre Dame was from 1995-2013 where he held positions as an English and Visual and Performing Arts teacher, Director of Student Activities and Department Chairperson. The Frank Ryerson Scholarship fund was established in 2015 to facilitate a Notre Dame student's ability to pursue her college and career goals through her preparation at NDB. The Scholarship is awarded at the Academic Awards Ceremony held annually in the spring semester.

### Application Criteria:

- 1) The student may apply during her junior year of enrollment at NDB with the scholarship award being applied to her senior year's tuition.
- 2) The student must have a minimum cumulative weighted grade point average of 3.25
- 3) The student must maintain active participation in the co-curricular and extracurricular life of the school.
- 4) The student must consistently demonstrate or express the following qualities:
  - a. Faith, Compassion, and Integrity;
  - b. Independent and Confident; and
  - c. Creativity and Engagement in the classroom.
- 5) The student must write a 500 words or less creative writing essay.
- 6) The student must complete the application in full.
- 7) The student must obtain two faculty recommendations referencing criteria number 3 and 4 listed above.
- 8) The student must demonstrate financial need by completing the school's annual tuition assistance program applications.

### Application Process:

- 1) Applicants pick up application form in room 100 or download from the Website.
- 2) Registrar confirms a minimum cumulative weighted grade point average of 3.25 for applicant and signs the application.
- 3) **Applicants submit a completed application form, an essay, a copy of her transcript and two sealed letters of recommendation. These are due to Mrs. Worthge in room 100b on Friday, January 25, 2019 by dismissal time. Late submissions will not be considered.**
- 4) The Chief Financial Officer confirms the applicant's demonstrated need through the submission of the tuition assistance application.
- 5) A scholarship committee of faculty and staff will review applicants and select the recipient.
