The Pennsylvania School Code, Health Services, requires medical examinations for children when entering school, and in grade 6 and 11, and dental examinations for children when entering school and in grade 3 and 7.

You are encouraged to have your child examined by your private physician and dentist if possible to provide for continuity of care to your child. Payment for any private exam is the parent’s responsibility. The attached private exam forms are to be completed by your physician/dentist and returned to the School Nurse.

If you wish to have the examinations performed at school, by the school physician/dentist you will be notified of the scheduled examinations during the school year.
