

ELECTRONICS POLICY

Palm Lane Elementary Charter School prohibits any use and/or any display of cell phones and other electronic devices on school campus. This policy allows cell phones only to be in a student's backpack (not visible) and turned to off. It is a violation of school policy for a cell phone to be turned to the "on" position or in "airplane mode" during school time. School time is considered to be from the moment a student steps onto PLCS property/campus (in the parking lot and certainly when within the gates of the school) to the moment they leave (outside the school's gates and not in the parking lot).

All other types electronic devices (IPODs, MP3 players, portable video game players, etc.) are strictly prohibited. All forms of electronic devices, including cell phones, not properly stored pursuant to this policy will be immediately confiscated by school personnel. Parents will be called to retrieve the item. Students may face school disciplinary action, including detention, suspension and/or expulsion if found in possession of these types of devices on any portion of school property. Repeated instances (more than 2) of possession of these types of items will result in suspension or expulsion.

PLECS and PLCS school personnel are **not** responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items that are prohibited on school property.
