Beginning this year, AP Exam Registration will take place in the fall.

Before Purchasing AP Exams:

- Each student must have a College Board account. If you do not already have one, you can create one at: www.collegeboard.com
- Students will obtain a “Join Code” from each of your AP teachers, and “join” their class on College Board.
- Students **must** order exam(s) on College Board then pay for it in Total Registration.

- After ordering your exam(s) through College Board, students must purchase AP exams at:

excused. Please plan to purchase your exam(s) as soon as possible to give yourself ample time to work through any difficulties.

Below are the dates and times for each AP Exam. Be advised that students should be ready to check in by **7:30 am** for the morning tests and **11:40 pm** for the afternoon tests. If you are not in your assigned seat and ready to test by the time the doors close, you will not be able to test and there are no refunds given.
