All girls and boys in K - 8th grade are welcome to sign up. Specific times and days for practices and games will be determined by the coaches. Your child should be ready to commit to 2 to 4 days a week starting in late August or early September until approximately end of October. Information regarding practices will be provided by the coaches.

To register for the team:

- **Read carefully** and fill out all requested information on **all forms and sign**.
- **PTA membership is required.** Print and complete the PTA membership form, and send to school in a separate envelope marked, "**PTA Membership**". **Please pay separately.**
- **Pay both separately by Check or Money Order (NO CASH) payable to Clissold PTA. The fees are listed on the release form.**
- Print and return the completed Release Form with appropriate fees to the school office in an envelope marked: "**Soccer Registration**".
- **Registration ends Friday, June 15, 2018**
- **All school fees must be paid. Contact Clissold School's Main Office school fees information.**

Clissold's sports programs are sponsored by the Clissold PTA and coordinated by volunteers on the PTA Sports Council. Clissold soccer teams league registration fees are paid for through PTA funds, registration fees and fundraising efforts. The soccer teams are coached by adult volunteers, and hopefully enjoyed by the children.

CLISSOLD PTA SPORTS
GUIDELINES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PARENTS AND PLAYERS

1. The Clissold Sports program is a PTA sponsored activity and requires membership. All athletes must be current students of Henry R. Clissold Elementary School.
2. Fees must be paid at the time of registration. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Fees are non-refundable once registration ends and teams have formed. A runner will be ineligible to participate until all fees are paid.
3. Eligibility: Athletes must follow the rules established by the school and the coaches regarding grades and behavior in order to remain on the team and have participation privileges. Students who receive a failing grade in any subject will be ineligible to participate in sports until the five-week progress report indicates a passing grade. Teachers or administration may be petitioned after a two and one-half week period to indicate a passing grade. Students who are suspended from school are ineligible to participate in practices or games on the day(s) of the Suspension. Participation may resume upon returning to school.
4. Following are the guidelines on practice and game time for the Clissold Sports Program and the coaches will do their best to make judgment decisions based on what is best for all athletes involved.
 - Competition is as follows: K or K-2nd grade, 1st/2nd Grade, 3rd/4th Grade, 5th/6th Grade, and 7/8 Grade.
 - Although Soccer is a competitive sport, fairness and sportsmanship should not be sacrificed.
 - Athletes who attend practices and show the ability in practice will be placed in a race according to their performance in practice.
5. Practices and Games
 - Schedule of practices, rules, schedules of games and other information will be distributed by coaches as soon as possible.
 - Every effort must be made regarding promptness and adherence to the time schedules. If there are unavoidable conflicts with game or practices consult with the coach. Absence and tardiness to practices and games will affect the performance in the games.
 - Practices (if applicable) are for athletes only. Unsupervised siblings are not allowed at practice.
 - Transportation to and from practices and games is the responsibility of the parents and the athletes.
 - Each athlete will receive a uniform. Proper care of the PTA issued uniform is required and the athlete must pay for a damaged or lost uniform before he or she can participate in any further PTA activities.
6. Parents must set a standard of respect for their children to follow and are expected to behave in a respectful manner at all times. If you have a problem with a coach discuss the issue with the coach first and if no satisfactory resolution is provided, then address the concern with the parent liaison of the Sports Council as opposed to discrediting the coach in front of your children. Before or after games can be emotional times for both the parent and the coach. Please choose another time to discuss your issues.
7. Consistent respect by athletes and parents for team members, opposing team members, game officials and property is an absolute requirement. A gross display of disrespect is grounds for disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the team. Parents may be asked to leave the venue, and barred from future games.
8. Clissold Sports teams are representatives of our school. Always reflect a positive image.
