

CLEAN CLASSROOM CHECKLIST

For an Asthma Friendly Environment!



- ü DAMP DUSTING AND MOPPING ARE DONE REGULARLY.
- ü CARPETS AND UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE ARE VACUUMED REGULARLY (WOOD, TILE, OR VINYL FLOOR COVERINGS ARE PREFERABLE).
- ü STUFFED TOYS ARE WASHED REGULARLY.
- ü FOOD IS STORED IN AIR TIGHT CONTAINERS.
- ü SIGNS OF "PESTS" SUCH AS COCKROACHES AND RODENTS ARE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY.
- ü CLOTHING STORED IN THE ROOM IS TAKEN HOME REGULARLY FOR WASHING.
- ü HEATING AND VENTILATION MAINTAIN A COMFORTABLE ROOM TEMPERATURE.
- ü UNUSUAL ODORS ARE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY.
- ü AN EFFECTIVE PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING MAINTENANCE CONCERNS IS IN PLACE.
- ü MOLD & MOISTURE PROBLEMS ARE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY, AND CLEANED WITHIN 24 HOURS. (I.E. CONDENSATION, DISCOLORATION, OR BUBBLING OR PEELING OF THE PAINT.)
