Support Courses

Credit Recovery

Classes offered will be for credit recovery ("F" grade in either semester). May be in person or online.

A-G Make-up Classes

A-G make-up classes will also be offered. Courses are offered as both traditional and online programs for students with a "D" in an A-G course.

High School Prep Academy (Contact site for dates)

Transition class is offered to students currently enrolled in 8th grade who earn an "F" grade in Math and ELA. It is a support class for students to transition to high school D students will be also accepted.

Enrichment Courses

Language Excels Academy

This academy is designed for Newcomer English Language Learners to help support and develop academic English language. Students will also be able to experience elective coursework as a part of this academy along with real world experiences.

AP Summer Success (Contact site for dates)

The Pre-AP Academy course is intended for students who have never taken an AP course. The content provides students with the foundational support necessary for successful completion of high school AP courses.

Bridge to Math II Plus 2 Week Course (June 18th - July 3rd or July 8th - July 23rd)

The bridge to Math II Plus is a course intended for students moving from Math I to the accelerated math course sequence, which includes Mathematics I Plus, and Mathematics II Plus.

Bridge to Math III Plus 4 Week Course (Contact site for dates)

The Bridge to Math III Plus is a course intended for students who have successfully completed Math II with a B or higher or have been recommended for Math III Plus in the 2019-2020 school year.

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Enrichment Course **Bridge to Accelerated Math 8**

The Bridge to Accelerated Math 8 is a course intended for students moving from Math 7 to the Accelerated Math 8. Students must have successfully completed Math 7 with a B or higher, or be recommended by their teacher for Accelerated Math 8. Students are highly recommended to have received Honors distinction in Math 7. Students will be assigned one period in the day for registration. If students do not participate, they cannot move to Accelerated Math 8. (3 weeks only)

Support Class for English & Math

ELA and Math support extended learning is offered to any student currently enrolled in grade 7. Support classes will be offered for students who earn and "F" grade in math and/or ELA in either semester. (Spring semester is based on third quarter grades)

Language Excels Academy

This academy is designed for Newcomer English Language Learners to help support and develop academic English language. Students will also be able to experience elective coursework as a part of this academy along with real world experiences.

Middle School Prep Academy

Transition class for incoming 7th graders. This a support in Math and English for 6th graders transitioning to middle school, and skill reinforcement.

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SPECIAL EDUCATION

Extended school year academic support is provided to students during this program. This program is designed to prevent regression of skills obtained during the regular school year based on I.E.P. goals.
