Distance Learning Implementation Notice

- **Monday, March 16** — Teachers and staff will report to school to plan for distance learning. **NO SCHOOL** for students.
- **Tuesday, March 17 to Tuesday, March 24** — Students will participate in distance learning.
- **Wednesday, March 25 to Tuesday, March 31** — Spring Break for students and teachers. There will no longer be a Spring Break period during the week April 13-17, 2020.
- **Wednesday, April 1** — Eagle Academy will resume operations.

We have developed resource packets for every grade level between grades Pre-Kindergarten through -3rd.
