This closure created a very successful Co-Ed Mary Star of the Sea High School and continues to be a very popular co-educational institution in our community. Many other Lasuen students attended San Pedro High School, and other surrounding schools throughout the community, after the closure.

It's now been 48 years that Fermin Lasuen High School closed. The closure of that school was hard on its students, but venturing out and creating new life-long friends was a blessing. Now after all these years it is obvious to see that San Pedro is a unique and very close community.
