The MS girls team scored a 61 for 2nd place, close behind 1st place Pentwater at 59! Leading the pack of 142 runners was Mellie Thompson 6th place, 15:11; Jackie Cole 22nd, 17:56; Kaitlin Buys, 32, 19:38. Kaleigh Griswold ran a PR, 48th place, 21:58; Isabelle Wahl, 54th, 23:17; Mallory Neglio, 57th, 24:07; Selah Meeuwes, 58th, 24:09; Alena Quigley, 61, 26:13; and Alexis Goehrig, 64th, 26:16.

The MS boys did not have enough runners to score as a team, but did run extremely well. Johnny Christensen placed 2nd place overall with a 13:24 time; Donald Thompson came in 7th in 15:12; and running his first meet of the season Zach Grasman placed 31st with his time of 19:37.
