The PreACT® will be administered at no cost (FREE) on Wednesday, February 20 at 8:25 am to students who sign up (space is limited). A FREE breakfast will be served from 7:30 am to test-takers with a valid school ID.

Beginning January 8 through Jan 16, 9th & 10th grade students may register for the PreACT® by submitting the form below to the College & Career Center. A school lunch may also be pre-ordered for ACT Test Day (Feb 20) using the same form. Please understand that the student’s meal account will be charged accordingly for lunch, even if the lunch is not picked up.
