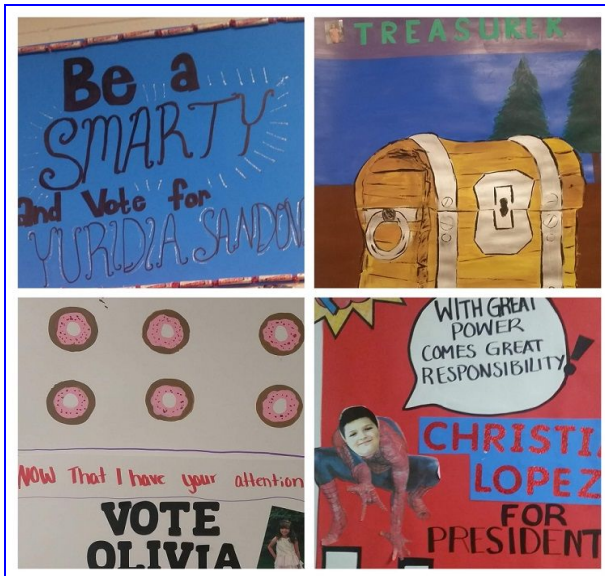




“Twombly Talk”
