Transfer Process and Information

Attention: Parent/Guardian:

Goliad ISD accepts transfer students based upon the criteria set forth in the Goliad ISD Policy (FDA – Legal & Local). The Goliad administration does not anticipate a tuition charge for 2019-2020. However, the Board of Trustees reviews tuition fees for transfer students before the start of each new school year.

Transfer packets may be picked up at the Administration Office at 161 N. Welch St.; at one of the campuses; or downloaded from our website at www.goliadisd.org;

Transfer Applications from current transfer students must be received on/before May 1, 2019.

Transfer Applications for new students requesting transfer must be received on/before May 30, 2019.

Transfer applications received after May 30, 2019 will be reviewed for transfer on a first come basis as availability permits.

Parents may be contacted regarding your application request for transfer. All student transfer applications and information are reviewed by designated campus personnel and final decision and approval made by the district superintendent. Parents will be notified regarding the decision to accept or deny transfer.

This Out-of-District Transfer request is made with the full understanding and agreement of the Goliad ISD Board Policy [<https://policyonline.tasb.org/Policy/Code/513?filter=FDA>] (FDA-Legal / FDA-Local) and the following:

A student entering grade K–12 who does not live in Goliad County may apply for transfer with the Goliad Independent School District.

If the District charges tuition, the amount shall be set by the Board, within statutory limits. The parent or guardian agrees to these tuition charges and understands the district may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.

Out of district transfers shall be granted for **one regular school year at a time**. Parent/guardian must apply for a renewal on an annual basis. **Renewals are not automatic or guaranteed for the upcoming school year.**

Transportation to and from school is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the transfer student.

A transfer student may request to ride a district bus. The transportation department will designate bus pick-up and drop-off points for transfer students within the district county line.

A transfer student in violation of the Student Code of Conduct, state and local attendance rules, lack of academic effort or attitude, or any of the District rules and regulations will result in denial of the transfer for the following school year

Transfer applications for 2019-2020 will be available beginning April 1, 2019. You may pick up a transfer packet at the Administration Building at 161 N Welch St, Goliad; at one of the campuses; or download the application from the Goliad ISD web page.

ALL completed transfer application; signed agreement and student required documentation must be submitted to the Goliad I. S. D. Administration Building, 161 N. Welch St., Goliad TX or mailed to Goliad I.S.D., Attn: Transfer Request; P. O. Box 830; Goliad TX 77963

Application for transfer consideration:

1. Children of Goliad ISD employees.
2. Student who is currently enrolled in Goliad ISD as a transfer student.
3. Student who has siblings currently enrolled in Goliad ISD.
4. Student whose parent/legal guardian is currently employed in Goliad County.
5. Student whose parent/legal guardian owns property in Goliad County.
6. Student moved out of Goliad county/school district during current school year.
7. Student who resides in another school district and wishes to attend Goliad ISD.

The District Superintendent and campus administrators, when considering initial transfer or continuance of transfer request, will consider the following (nonexclusive) reasons:

1. Whether admission of the student would cause overcrowding of classes or require the District to add personnel, programs, or buildings;
2. The student's conduct record;
3. The student's attendance record; and
4. The student's school academic records including STAAR / EOC and other test scores; and
5. Cooperation by the student's parents.

Transfer applications from current transfer students must be **received on/before May 1, 2019** to be reviewed for the next school year. Parents will be notified the last week of May if application has been approved.

Transfer applications for New Transfer Request must be **received on/before May 30, 2019** to be reviewed for the next school year. Parents will be notified of approval or denial by August 1, 2019.

Transfer applications **received after May 30, 2019** will be stamped and reviewed for transfer on a first come basis.

Returning and New approved transfer students must have completed all required student registration and be in attendance on the first day classes begin the Fall semester or the transfer application becomes null and void.
