



## Medication Forms Required

If your child needs:	Then the following is required:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Over-the-Counter (Non-Prescription) Medication or Products:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <u>Any</u> over the counter type of medication (pain reliever, topical lotion, ointment, throat lozenges, eye drops, vitamins, supplements etc.) or</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Any prescription medication</li> <li>• For Inhalers, Epinephrine or Benadryl see boxes below</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <a href="#">Parent-Physician medication release</a> <i>signed by parents and a Medical Doctor</i></li> <li>2. All medications must be in the original container.</li> <li>3. Prescription medications require the current prescription label.</li> <li>4. If doctor signs non-Rocklin Academy form (ex: Kaiser form), then parents still need to sign the Rocklin Academy <b>Parent-Physician medication release</b></li> <li>5. General Medications cannot be carried by a student. Only rescue meds can be carried by a student.</li> </ol>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inhaler / Asthma Medication*</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <a href="#">Asthma Action Plan</a> <i>signed by parents and a Medical Doctor</i></li> <li>2. If doctor signs non-Rocklin Academy form (ex: Kaiser form), then parents still need to sign the Rocklin Academy <a href="#">Parent-Physician medication release</a>.</li> </ol> <p>* If student self-carries, then it must be indicated by the MD on the <b>Asthma Action Plan</b> and student and parent need to complete self-carry contract.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Epinephrine / Benadryl</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <a href="#">Parent-Physician medication release</a> <i>signed by parents</i></li> <li>2. <a href="#">FARE Form</a> <i>signed by parents and a Medical Doctor</i></li> <li>3. <a href="#">Allergy History Form</a> <i>signed by parents</i></li> </ol> <p>If student self-carries, then it must be indicated by the MD on the <b>FARE form</b> and student and parent need to complete self-carry contract.</p>
<b>For Field Trips:</b>	All of the above required documentation must be turned into the school office no less than two weeks prior to the field trip.
<b>Rescue Meds that can be carried by a student:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inhaler</li> <li>• EpiPen</li> <li>• Glucagon</li> </ul>

**Medication can only be accepted if:**

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The paperwork is signed and complete</li> <li>• Medication is in the original container</li> <li>• Delivered by a parent, guardian or designated adult</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prescription label is included</li> <li>• Medication is current (not expired)</li> <li>• Medication matches doctor's orders</li> </ul> |
