BACKGROUND:

Kahuku High and Intermediate School is known as "The Pride of the North Shore" and serves nearly 1,400 students in grades seven through twelve. Students come from the communities that span a 25-mile stretch along the North Shore of O'ahu, from Ka'a'awa to Pupukea. KHIS has served generations of students and established a long and proud tradition of academic, artistic, and athletic excellence since the school first opened its doors in 1897.

KHIS is home to the Ke Kula Kaiapuni Hawai'i 'o Kahuku Academy that provides students the opportunity to learn, speak, and address local and global issues in the Hawaiian language. KHIS has also recently partnered with Windward Community College to enable students to receive dual-credit for courses and will enable a 2021 cohort class to earn a high school diploma and an Associates of Arts Degree at the same time. KHIS has over 46% of students on free and/or reduced lunch and has participated in the AVID program for over a decade.
