What is PBIS?

PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Interventions and Support.

Positive behavior support is a behavior management system used to understand what maintains an individual's challenging behavior. People's inappropriate behaviors are difficult to change because they are functional; they serve a purpose for them. These behaviors are supported by reinforcement in the environment.

Student Reminders

1. All students **MUST** wear their Identification Card.
2. **NO** eating or drinking is permitted in classrooms.
3. Students are allowed to wear hoodies; however, they must follow the parish policy (school color with school logo and school-issued jackets are permitted). Unpermitted hoodies are not to be worn within the building.
4. Caps and boots are not to be worn on campus.
5. Car riders need to be here by 7:35 each day.
