Declaration of Obsolete/Surplus Property (Portable Buildings)

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 17545(a) states "The governing board of any school district may sell for cash any personal property belonging to the district if the property is not required for school purposes, or if it should be disposed of for the purpose of replacement, or if it is unsatisfactory or not suitable for school use"; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to dispose of obsolete/surplus of two portable classroom buildings (Rooms 35-38; and Rooms 39-43) located at Pioneer Elementary School, 32737 Bel Aire Street, Union City, CA 94587.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board finds that the portable buildings at Pioneer Elementary School, are the property of this District and are not required for school purposes and should be disposed of as they are not suitable for school use; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board intends and does hereby declare its intention to sell or salvage the surplus and obsolete portable buildings as stated, and that the Chief Business Officer, or her designee is hereby designated to represent the Board to dispose of said portable buildings described above.

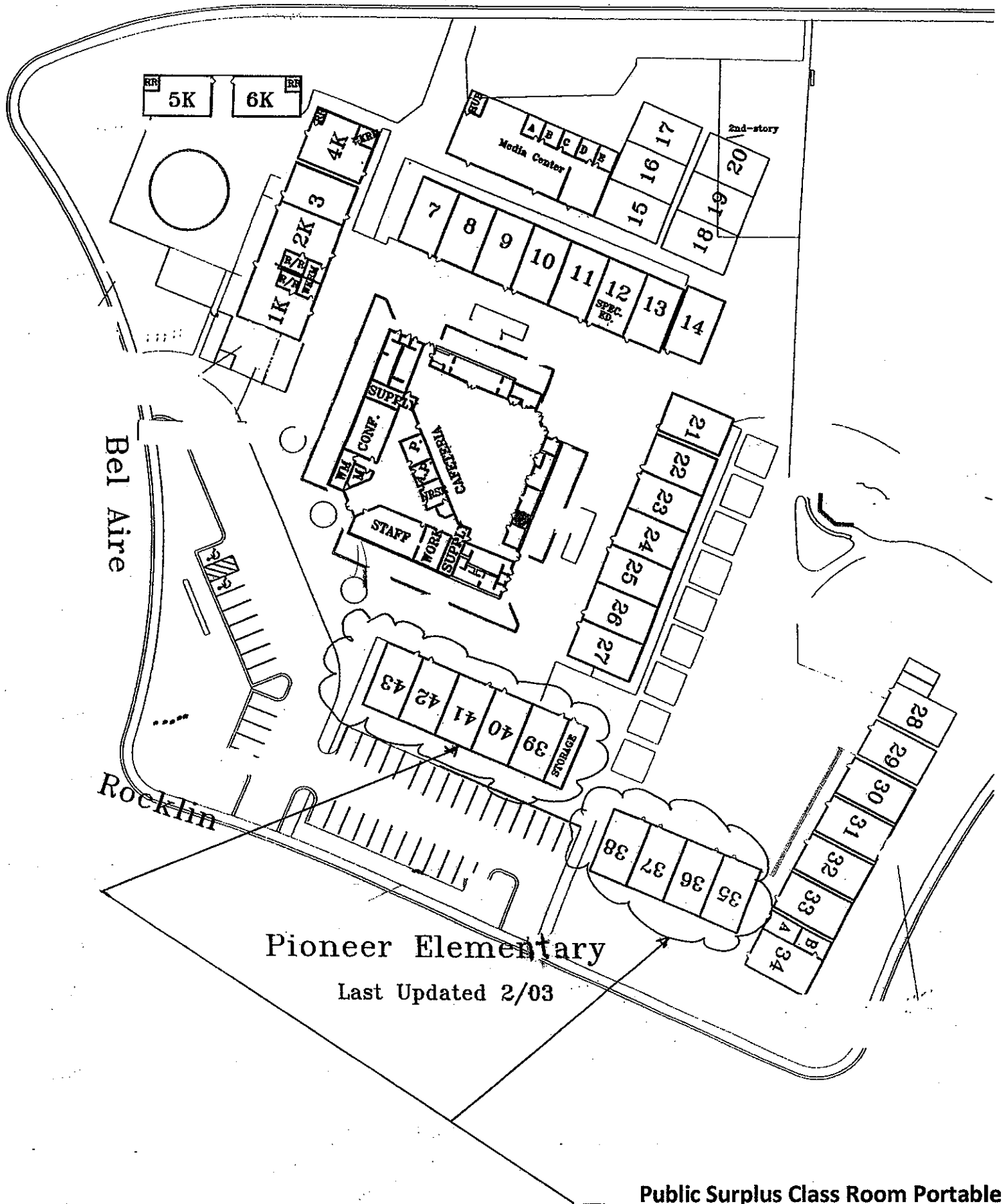
