Dear Cheney High School Families:

Spring has almost sprung and we wanted to reach out and notify you that on Thursday, March 14th and Friday, March 15th, our district is holding parent-teacher conferences. It is an excellent opportunity for you to engage in rich discussion around your student and their academic progress. We look forward to seeing those of you who are choosing to join us.

At Cheney High School, teachers will be available in their classrooms to meet with you individually on a drop in basis. Because we have over 1300 students enrolled this spring, ***we are encouraging students that are struggling academically and their parents to attend, particularly those with D's and F's.*** Our schedule is as follows:

- Thursday, March 14th - 11:30AM-7:00PM, (teacher dinner break - 3pm-3:30pm)
- Friday, March 15th - 7:50AM-3:00PM, (teacher lunch break - 11:30-12:00pm)
- Pick up a classroom map from the front office area at the main entrance.
 - Conference with as many teachers as you would like, limiting your conversations to 10 minutes per teacher to allow for the next family to engage in conferencing.
 - Conversations are on a first come, first serve basis. If you are concerned with making sure you have time set aside with a particular teacher, please e-mail that teacher specifically so that they can arrange to set aside the time you need if at all possible.
 - Keep in mind that there will be times where your student's teacher is pulled away for a specific teaming conference and may not be available.
 - Concerned with multiple classes? Contact your counselor to arrange a time to meet with multiple teachers at one sitting. The teachers will attend to the best of their scheduling abilities.
- Cannot attend, or feel that your student is progressing fine academically and just want to check in with a teacher? Feel free to call or e-mail teachers during this time frame instead. Virtual conferencing is always an option available to families and may be a more time-effective option.

Again, thank you all for sharing your students with us at Cheney High School. We look forward to seeing you!
