A-G requirements

A - 2 years of Social Science - World History/US History/Govt

B - 4 years of English

C - 3 years of math (Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2)

D - 2 years science (1 year life, 1 year physical)

E - 2 years Language Other Than English (Spanish/ASL)

F - 1 year Visual/Performing Art

G - 1 year College Prep Elective

If you earned an A or B in 1st semester of English 3, consider choosing AP Literature or DE English 101/103 if you have a GPA of 3.0 or higher

If you earned a C or D in 1st semester of English 3, consider choosing ERWC

AP Language → **AP Literature or DE English 101/103**

If you earned an A or B or C in 1st semester of AP Language, choose AP Literature or DE English 101/103 if you have a GPA of 3.0 or higher

If you earned a D in 1st semester of AP Language, consider choosing ERWC

DE English 101/103 → **AP Literature or ERWC**

If you earned an A or B or C in DE English 101, choose DE English 103

If you earned a D in DE English 101, choose ERWC

AP - Advanced Placement, more rigorous, working towards taking AP exam and possibly earning college credit

DE - Dual Enrollment - Mt. San Jacinto College courses in regular school day, earn college credit and high school credit

Student Aide/Student Tutor

- 2.0 gpa minimum for Aide



Unscheduled

Seniors who meet the following criteria may be unscheduled 1st or 6th period:

- Must be on track to graduate.
- Must be on track to meet A-G requirements,
- Positive attendance and behavior.
- Parent and administration must approve.
- To be eligible for Valedictorian/Salutatorian students must be enrolled in at least 6 classes all 4 years

All seniors must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes.
