

## Hattiesburg Public School District Accountability Information

As a result of the State of Mississippi receiving a *No Child Left Behind (NCLB)* waiver regarding school choice, Hattiesburg Public Schools is **NO** longer providing an option of school choice for schools in school improvement.

**Exception:** Students who opted for school choice in 2011-2012 may continue attending the school in which they were registered for 2011-2012 **IF FAMILIES PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION.** This option will remain until the child has transitioned to the N.R. Burger Middle School.
