### Chapel

Our first chapel of the year was on Thursday morning. Students sat with their chapel partners as we participated in a service led by Pastor Punke from Zion Lutheran Church.

#### *What is a chapel partner?*

Chapel partners are older students assigned to younger students to help them follow along in weekly chapel, as well as foster relationships across the school. During our first activity, each partner was given a paper where they wrote their birthday, favorite color, favorite game, Bible verse, and superhero. Parents, look for these papers (on half-sheets in the shape of a superhero emblem). They will be in older student's planners or in folders with younger students. Please remember your child's chapel partner in prayer and also on their birthday with a special card and special notes throughout the year.

#### *What are the offering envelopes for?*

As part of each weekly chapel service, we will collect an offering to go towards a designated mission project. Chapel envelopes will be send home early each week. These chapel offerings are collected in your student's classroom and then brought forward at a special time during the chapel service on Thursdays. Please remember to send in an offering each week.
