Remember, fulfilling your Development requirements is one of the expectations for those receiving in-parish tuition. Development Requirements include:

- Fulfilling a pledge to the Making-a-Difference Annual Appeal
- Submitting \$20 per student for class auction projects
- Procuring \$200 (\$300 cash only after the procurement deadline) in goods, services or cash for the STAAR Auction
- Getting \$85 in pledges, per student, for the Jog-a-Thon
- Volunteering 36 hours (18 for single-parent households) at the school and/or the parish, including one Development Activity and one PTC Event

All school families are invited to attend the 10am ordination service at St. James in Seattle on

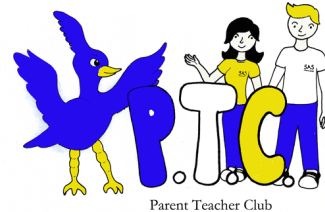
