Dear Families of Bishop Foley High School,

I write to inform you that there has been a complaint made by a student at Bishop Foley High School to local law enforcement regarding school president Fr. Gerry LeBoeuf, who also serves as pastor of Guardian Angels Catholic Church in Clawson. The Madison Heights Police Department has opened an investigation.

School, parish, and archdiocesan officials are cooperating fully with this process. Fr. LeBoeuf has been placed on administrative leave and he is restricted from public ministry until this matter is resolved. As this is an active investigation, no further details will be shared at this time.

Monsignor Timothy Hogan has been appointed temporary administrator of Guardian Angels Parish. Kevin Kijewski, J.D., Superintendent of Schools, will serve as interim president of Bishop Foley High School.
