Attendance:

Courses taught during the summer condense and concentrate the instructional content of courses offered during the regular school year, so attendance during the summer session is crucial. Students may not be absent more than **three** times to receive credit.

Behavior:

Overt acts of misbehavior, behavior that interferes with the education of others or threatens the safety of students or teachers on the school grounds or in the classroom, will not be tolerated and may result in suspension or dismissal from summer school. Any day of suspension will be counted as a day of absence. All school rules, including appropriate school dress, smoking, drug, alcohol and cheating, will be enforced. Failure to abide by these rules may result in the student being removed from summer school and the denial of credit.

Step 1 – COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION FORM: Return completed form to your counselor.

Step 2 – COMPLETE OFL REGISTRATION: Complete the OFL Registration process. Hart District students must register with OFL to participate in summer school (Hart partners with OFL to provide summer classes). OFL will also be arranging early-bird appointments for registration. Beginning 3/2/20, you may call **626-813-6900** to schedule an appointment any time between 4/27/20-6/5/20. If you cannot attend any early-bird appointment times, proceed to Step 3.

Step 3 – ATTEND MANDATORY REGISTRATION MEETING: Attend one of the mandatory registration sessions. A parent/legal guardian must attend with each student.
