The State Department of Education Office of Nutrition and Health through the Team Nutrition Grant Partners conducted a 4-day training at Colleton County High School in Walterboro, SC, July 31 through August 3rd. The training was managed and conducted by Culinary Partners. Hampton One Food Service Managers and Staff took advantage of the opportunity to participate in free training with a Chef during that week. Staff spent 20 hours in the kitchen preparing meals with a certified chef and 10 hours in the classroom discussing nutrition, marketing, and food safety strategies. In addition to the knowledge and skills development, staff received their own chef jacket, hat, and other culinary tools, posters and materials for their schools.

Registration Procedures

Parents / Guardians without internet access can complete the online portion at the district office.

Go to: hampton1.org/registration

Click Start and create a username and password.

Enter the student(s) information.

Create an appointment for final registration clearance.

Bring the following items to your appointment:

- ___ Birth Certificate
- ___ Social Security Card (preferred not required)
- ___ Immunization form (DHEC)
- ___ Proof of Residency (one of the following)
 - ___ Utility bill with physical address
 - ___ Lease/rental agreement
 - ___ Property tax receipt with physical home address
- ___ School Transcript or Report Card
- ___ Guardianship documents if not the parent.
- ___ Parent / Guardian Driver's License or Identification

NOTE: Registration cannot continue without the **birth certificate**, **proof of residency**, and if applicable the **guardianship documents**.
