

This is a Moody ISD follow up statement to our Friday call out concerning the rash of flu like absences. Thank you to our parents and staff who have been supportive and have kept children home who have had fever and other symptoms. Thank you for taking the necessary medical steps to ease your child's symptoms and discomfort. As of end of day on Wednesday 2/6/2019 we have had 43 total confirmed student cases of the flu in our district, along with 4 employee cases. There have been other absences but they have not been confirmed flu cases but absences due to colds, viruses etc. Our nursing staff is in constant contact with the McLennan County Health department and we are continuing to clean and sanitize our buildings and buses. We are utilizing extra staff as of today to be sure we sanitize and clean every area. We ask that you continue to cooperate with us by keeping children who have fever at home. Also, be sure to take necessary precautions at home to sanitize and clean any areas that could be contaminated. Please refrain from posting unfactual and erroneous information on social media as this only hurts our students, community and school.
