Students who do not send in the completed registration form with tuition by the deadline date will be at risk of not being admitted to the program. Students should complete and mail one form for each session to Decatur High School. No refunds will be made except in situations where there are not enough students to justify a class or if a class closes due to a maximum number of students.

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Summer School

Program: Summer School is open to Decatur City Schools high school students who need a full semester class. Courses will be determined during the registration process. Classes should have a minimum of ten students before a class is offered and classes will be limited in size. Students will be registered in the class in the order of the completed student registration form and tuition is received. Student registration for sessions does not guarantee a class will be offered. Students should register early or they will be in risk of not being enrolled in summer school.

Students should bring a pair of ear buds or headphones to use with the computer-based instruction.

Lunch: Students will be allowed to leave campus during the lunch period from 11:30 – 12:00 noon. Students have the option of bringing their lunch and staying at Decatur High School during lunch break. Students will not be allowed to order out for lunch or have lunch delivered.

Behavior: Disruptive or inappropriate behavior will lead to dismissal. Decisions of the administration in charge of summer school will be final. There will be no refund of tuition to students that are dismissed. The Code of Student Conduct and dress code will be strictly enforced.

Absences: Only illness with doctors' excuse or death in the family is excused. More than one absence for any reason will result in the student being withdrawn from the course without credit or refund of fees. Two tardies will equal one absence.

Note: The Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA) will only allow a maximum of two (2) credits earned during summer sessions to be applied toward eligibility.

Credit Recovery

Program: Credit Recovery is open to Decatur City Schools high school students who scored between 41-59 in their previous attempt in this course and need to recover specific standards to earn credit. Courses will be determined during the registration process. Classes should have a minimum of ten students before a class is offered and classes will be limited in size. Students will be registered in the class in the order of the completed student registration form and tuition is received. Student registration for summer sessions does not guarantee a class will be offered. Students should register early or they will be in risk of not being enrolled in summer school.

Students should bring a pair of ear buds or headphones to use with the computer-based instruction.

Lunch: Students will be allowed to leave campus during the lunch period from 11:30 – 12:00 noon. Students have the option of bringing their lunch and staying at Decatur High School during lunch break. Students will not be allowed to order out for lunch or have lunch delivered.

Behavior: Disruptive or inappropriate behavior will lead to dismissal. Decisions of the administration in charge of summer school will be final. There will be no refund of tuition to students that are dismissed. The Code of Student Conduct and dress code will be strictly enforced.

Absences: Only illness with doctors' excuse or death in the family is excused. More than one absence for any reason will result in the student being withdrawn from the course without credit or refund of fees. Two tardies will equal one absence.

Note: A maximum grade of 70 may be awarded in a Credit Recovery course.

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
