## (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)

<b>Arrival</b> 7:20 - 7:40	Every morning students arrive at Mission Prep and are greeted with a handshake.
Breakfast & Bright Work 7:20 - 8:00	After students arrive, they walk to their classroom where they are greeted by their teacher. Students prepare for the day with a healthy breakfast and participate in morning bright work.
Community Meeting 8:00 - 8:15	Students begin the day with a classroom community meeting to positively reinforce academic and behavioral progress. Meetings include class and school chants that reinforce the college-preparatory mission, core values, and culture of high expectations of Mission Prep.
	*On Fridays, we hold grade-level Community Meetings.
Shared Reading 8:15 - 8:30	Students participate in whole class shared reading experiences to practice reading fluency and phonics skills.
<b>Literacy Rotations</b> 8:30 - 9:50	During this time there are two-teachers in the classroom leading small-group differentiated guided reading and phonics instruction.
<b>Snack</b> 9:50 - 10:00	To ensure students have the energy and sustenance they need to stay focused on learning between breakfast and lunch, we provide a 10-minute snack.
Handwriting 10:00 - 10:15	Students are explicitly taught handwriting skills and have the opportunity to practice those skills daily.
<b>Writing</b> 10:15 - 11:00	Students learn and practice grade level writing of narrative, informative and opinion pieces.
<b>Lunch</b> 11:00 - 11:20	Students will break for 20 minutes daily to eat a nutritious lunch.
Free Play 11:20 - 11:40	Students have 20 minutes for supervised outdoor free time with their grade level.
Read Aloud / Vocabulary 11:40 - 12:10	Teachers read aloud books and focus on teaching advanced reading comprehension and literary analysis skills that include scaffolded questions to engage all students and build higher-level literacy skills.
Social Studies / Science 12:10 - 12:55	Science and social studies units rotate throughout the year. Students learn about their community and history through engaging read alouds and projects. Science units
<b>Enrichment</b> 12:55 - 1:40	During Enrichment, students may attend classes in subjects as Music, Art, Technology, or Spanish Language.
<b>Brain Break</b> 1:40 - 1:50	Students are given a dedicated break time in the afternoon to use the restroom.
<b>Math</b> 1:50 - 3:10	
Physical Education (PE) 3:10 - 3:30	Students participate in daily outdoor physical education. During this time, students learn how to play different sports and games, and reinforces the concepts of fitness, nutrition, teamwork, and fair play.
<b>Choice Time</b> 3:30 - 3:50	During this structure time, students are given a choice of age-appropriate play options.
<b>Pack-Up</b> 3:50 - 4:00	Students reflect on the day by writing in their Learning Logs, then they clean up and pack up in preparation for dismissal at 4:00.
