A break is given at midday for participants to eat sack lunches. Bring a lunch and enjoy the day.

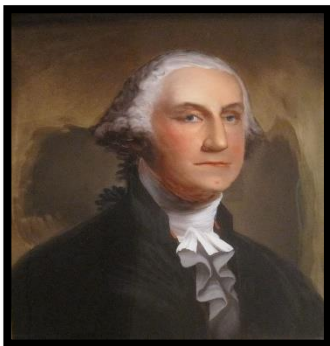
You can also purchase a lunch across the street at the coffee shop (*Coffee shop is separate from Julian Mining Co.*)
