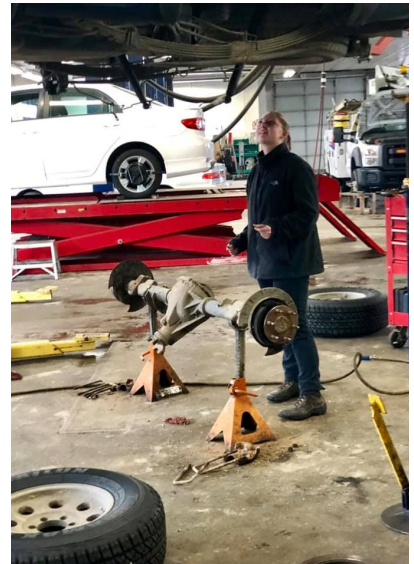
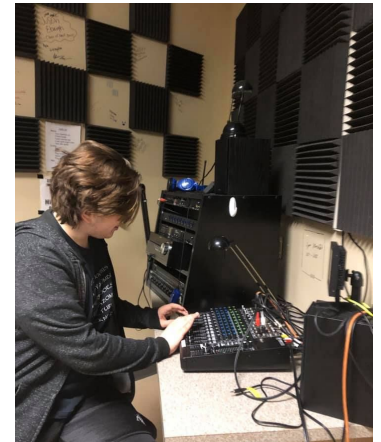
Real World Learning
