



Fontbonne Hall Academy 2019 SAT/ACT Prep Course
Course Description

Fontbonne is excited to once again offer a our SAT and ACT test prep course.

Enrolled students will take a 4-week 12 hour course that meets once a week in order to familiarize students with the format of the test leading to the **May/June SAT and ACT Exams**. This will cover the entire SAT test, all 4 areas of the SAT: Math, Reading, Writing/ Language, and the Essay. This year the ACT will also be covered: the English, Science, Reading, Writing, and Math sections. This course is designed for students with little or no experience with this standardized test. Students will be instructed on the differences between the two tests, understanding the layout and structure of the exams. The course also teaches skills and techniques to implement on the tests. This class format allows students to engage in more intense 3 hours sessions with fewer date commitments. Students not only become familiar and improve their scores, but also have skills to continue studying on their own after the course as well.
