In your two Theology classes this year, *The Mission of Jesus Christ* and *Jesus Christ's Mission Continues in the Church*, you are studying the community of the followers of Jesus Christ which Luke describes in the Acts of the Apostles: *They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers. . . All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need. Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people.*

Reflecting upon your experience of performing Christian Service, how has your baptism into the Christian community been lived out? What are the similarities and differences between the early Christian community described above and your experience performing Christian service as a Father Judge High School sophomore today? Why did you choose your particular service site? What gifts of the Holy Spirit were developed within you as you performed your service? What qualities of a Salesian gentleman did you demonstrate as you served? Finally, discuss whether or not you would want to do the same service next year.
