  - a. Review revised School Plan and budget. Dr. Salehi shared the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) and data of SBAC scores and Dash Board for 2016-17 within the SPSA.   - a. ELAC/DELAC-There is an ELAC meeting tomorrow for ELAC. There is a parent workshop on PowerSchool on September 20, 2018. At the DELAC meeting at the district, they talked about the SBAC results and will share out how many students were reclassified under ELPAC.
