

## El Segundo Unified School District Student Instructions for Logging into the ESUSD Network

### New method for internet browsing:

El Segundo Unified School District will be implementing a new method for students logging on the internet from outside the network. For our Middle and High School students that take home an iPad will require an authentication layer of security. This method will be nothing new for students because they will be using the same username and password they currently use for Unified Classroom (which includes PowerSchool & Learning (formerly Haiku)) and email.

### Step 1: Connect to a Wi-Fi Connection.



### Step 2: Tap on the Internet Login App on your iPad. Once you tap on the App you will be re-directed to the new Login screen.



**Step 3:** Type in your Username and Password in the requested fields.

Username: first initial last name \_ graduation year (i.e. jdoe\_25)

Password: Esusd & your 5 digit ID number & "!" (i.e. Esusd12345!)

Server: Authentication

Click Login. Once you are logged in, you will remain signed in for 8 hours.
