We have partnered with Google to be able to use Google Suite for Education. This includes but not limited to: email, Google apps, Docs, Slides, and so on. This parental consent form is here to request your permission for your student to use Google Suite.

JGISD will make every reasonable effort to monitor student activity on their devices and accounts. This includes monitoring at school by teachers and electronic monitoring. We are also able to monitor and record browsing history when the devices are at home. We reserve the right to revoke a student's account if it is seen that the student has violated the school's Acceptable Use Policy.

Google collects information on devices used by students.

- Device Information
- Logging information, including how the service is used
- Location information, including IP, GPS, and other sensors
- Unique application numbers
- Cookies and similar technologies

"Information we collect may be shared outside of Google in limited circumstances. We do not share personal information with companies, organizations and individuals outside of Google unless one of the following circumstances applies":

- With User consent
- With G Suite for Education administrators
- For external procession
- For Legal reasons

Each student 8th grade through 12th grade will receive a Chromebook and access to the school's Google Suite. Chromebooks are effective ways for teachers to deliver instruction and for students to complete assignments.
