Dear Upper School Parents and Students,

In preparation for the 2019-2020 school year, all students entering/returning to ECS in grades 7 through students entering Algebra II will be required to complete a Summer Math Review Booklet. The booklet will provide the necessary practice for your child to be “ready” for the expectations of his/her new grade level. Each page has been prepared so that your child will maintain and/or reinforce the foundational skills essential for success in mathematics.

It has been our experience that upon return to school in August, many prerequisite mathematical skills are lost due to the absence of regular practice over the summer. The loss of these skills may contribute to unnecessary frustration and possible lack of success for students as they begin their next level of mathematical study in the new school year.

This booklet is designed specifically for our students to give a brief review for thirty days over summer break. An answer key is provided at the back of each booklet, and instructions are given at the beginning of the booklet. Even though answer keys are provided, we encourage parents to remove these in order to most effectively assist students. Completed books should be turned in to each child’s math teacher on Back to School Orientation Night, August 8th. **These booklets will result in a test grade based upon full completion by each student.**

**Summer Math Booklets are now available in the school office, free of charge. Please ensure that you have picked up a booklet prior to June 28<sup>th</sup>.**
