Program Description

The IWCS summer school program will provide students with the opportunity to take a new course during the summer for high school credit. This will open-up their schedule during the school year and give them more flexibility to take advanced classes (AP, Dual Enrollment), add additional electives or participate in regional programs (Governor’s Schools). The tuition-based program will be delivered in an online format and will be facilitated by an IWCS teacher. Students must have access to the internet outside of school.

Course Offerings

Health & PE 9 - 1 Credit
Health & PE 10 - 1 Credit

Econ. & Personal Finance
- 1 Credit

Health & PE 9 & 10 are offered free during the school year with the Driver Education Classroom course embedded into the 10th grade health class. Driver Education Classroom is NOT offered during the summer class. VDOE does have a virtual driving classroom course for a \$109 cost. The registration is at <http://vadriveredu.org/login/index.php>. There are also numerous private driving schools in the area that charge for classroom and behind-the-wheel instruction.

Program Dates

June 24 – August 4

Registration is open through June 7. See your school counselor for more details and to register for a class.

Student Tuition

Tuition: \$250 for currently enrolled IWCS students; \$290 for non IWCS students. (Courses will need to meet a minimum enrollment of 10 students to be offered.)

Student Registration

May 13 - June 7

After June 7, students who withdraw from the program will be refunded at the following rate

- June 8 - June 13 -- \$150
- After June 13 -- No Refund



FAQs for High School Summer Program 2019

- IWCS will be offering 3 classes for new credit over the summer: Health/PE 9; Health/PE10 and Economics and Personal Finance.
- Share the information flyer about the program with parents of eligible students (rising 8th—10th grade) using your website, e-news, SchoolWay, AlertNow, etc.
- Instructional delivery is completely online, so students must have access to the internet outside of school.
- The course teacher of record will be an IWCS H/PE teacher.
- Registration will run until Friday, June 7 when enrollment closes.
- Tuition for currently enrolled IWCS students is \$250; tuition is \$290 for others.
- Payment for each course should be made to Smithfield High through the guidance department. A student will not be considered “registered” until full payment is received. Rising 8th graders will register with Smithfield High guidance department.
- If the class does not make, payment will be refunded.
- After June 7, students who withdraw from the program will be refunded at the following rate:
 - June 8 - June 13 -- \$150 refund
 - After June 13 -- no refund
- If non-IWCS students inquire about the courses and want to register, they would need to make a check out to **Smithfield High School**. Approval from their home school is required.
- There will be an orientation meeting with parents and students before the school year ends. Registered students will be called by the teacher with details of the meeting.
- Students taking PE10 - The driver’s ed component is **not** inclusive. VDOE requires that all high school students taking the in-classroom section of Driver’s Education during the summer must enroll in an approved DOE course. Link is below...the class cost is \$109.00
