

Esperanza Bridge Pass Request Form

IMPORTANT FAQ:

1. **The bridge is the safest means to cross Kellogg** as it keeps students out of the path of vehicles.
2. **Any student requesting a bridge pass must have a verified condition** preventing them from safely using the bridge with the rest of the student body.
3. **Student MUST keep bridge pass with them at all times on campus**, and may be required to use the bridge if unable to display their bridge pass to bridge supervisor.
4. **Bridge passes may only be used by the specific student they are issued to** unless the student is using crutches, wheelchair, or otherwise requires physical assistance from a friend/classmate.
