Red Bluff Joint Union High School District is reapplying for the 21st Century High School After School Safety and Enrichment for Teens Program. The purpose of the 21st Century High School After School Safety and Enrichment for Teens (ASSETs) program is to provide local flexibility in the establishment or expansion of community learning centers that provide our students in grades 9-12 with academic enrichment opportunities. Activities are designed to complement students' regular academic program, provide assistance with career exploration, literacy and related educational development, service for the families of these students, and a safe environment for students participating in the program. Previous ASSETs funding will be exhausted at the end of the 2018-2019 school year. ASSETs funding is highly competitive. Applicants awarded an ASSETs grant may receive five one-year grants subject to semi-annual attendance reporting.
