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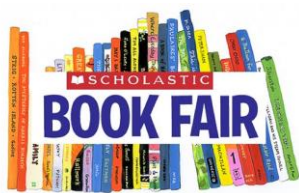
### School News

- Peer Mentors: Helping and directing younger peer mentors to help during recesses.

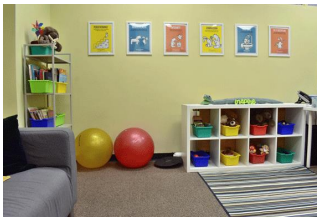


## School Band News

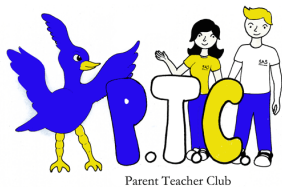


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## After School Chess Club: Classes Start this Friday

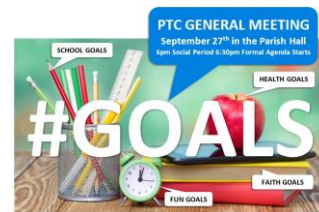

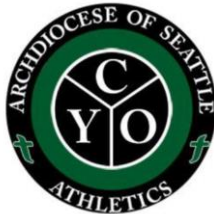
